Questions on 8-15-07 WQ discussion items

Port's Clean Water Action Plan - what is included in the framework, i.e. what measures is the Port considering to prevent urban and industrial runoff, soil contamination and air deposition? What measures will be included in Port leases or tariff? What measures will require approval or implementation by other agencies and how will they be funded and enforced?

TMDLs - What chemicals, organic and inorganic compounds are included in this study, what are the likely sources, what permits or NPDES permits are being considered relative to this study, what is the process for implementing reductions in permitted releases of pollutants, how long will it take, who enforces these permits and how - physical testing or just reports from pollutant contributors?

IRWMP, other grant proposals – What projects are being proposed for funding in the 2007-2008 cycle that will improve WQ in the harbor? Has the Port applied for other WQ grant funds and for what? What other WQ grant funds are available and through what agencies?

Wetlands restoration in harbor – Review Nov 15, 2006, Draft Port assessment of suggested harbor area mitigation sites, opportunities and constraints. Can obstacles be overcome at sites that would provide benefits to the Port and community?
