#### **LA Waterfront**



- Established as the City of Los Angeles' official waterfront in 2005
- Over 400 acres of waterfront property within POLA
- Includes the communities of Wilmington and San Pedro
- 15 Marinas
- 3,736 recreational vessel slips and dry docks
- Visited by nearly 2 million visitors each year
- Over 500,000 passengers board more than 100 cruise ships annually
- Home to nearly 100 public events including <u>LA Fleet Week®</u>
- Home to:
  - the Battleship IOWA Museum,
  - the <u>SS Lane Victory</u>,
  - the Cabrillo Marine Aquarium,
  - the LA Maritime Museum, and
  - Banning's Landing

- Public Access Investment Plan
- Create community amenities that separate Wilmington from Port operations
- Increases economic opportunity
- Connects Wilmington with its historic waterfront
- Provides regional linkages and pedestrian enhancements

Construction Completion: December 2023















Project Budget: \$65 million
















